The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) has completed its evaluation of your company's EarthGuard dust palliative and EarthGuard Fiber Matrix soil stabilizer. Based on information provided, we have determined that your products meet our requirements for these types of products. Accordingly, EarthGuard and EarthGuard Fiber Matrix have been placed on the qualified products list (QPL) under subsection 637.02.01 for optional dust palliative and subsection 726.03.13 for soil stabilizer respectively (see attached). Your products will remain on the QPL as long as their performance is satisfactory. Poor performance in the field will result in suspension or removal from the QPL as per established NDOT product evaluation procedures.

It must be emphasized that QPL is only used to pre-qualify products and should not be construed as a performance guaranty on the part of Terra Novo Inc. Also, product approval is not intended as an endorsement by NDOT.
